# English Language Institute

- The Fayetteville State University (FSU) Intensive English Language Institute (ELI) will provide an exceptional learner –centered 4-week program that provides 96 hours of “English as a Second Language” (ESL) instruction combined with recreational and cultural activities that will enhance their language skills and cultural understanding of the United States.
- Students will receive Continuing Education Credits and a Certificate of Completion from Fayetteville State University
- Dates: July 6 to August 1, 2015



# English Language Institute

Fayetteville State University offers an educational and cultural exchange through the Summer Institute for International Students. This program will expose international students to English Language and American culture. It will provide an American college experience to students aged 18 to 35 under experienced teachers who are English speakers. This co-educational and residential program will improve language skills and enhance cross cultural awareness.

- English Language Immersion with 24 hours instruction per week
- Cultural Immersion & recreational activities
- Highly diverse environment with international students
- Interactions designed to improve English language skills
- Service learning component
- Visit to Washington D.C. and other historical and cultural places in North and South Carolina

# Program Description

- **Program Description**
- The ELI offers a complete and rigorous ESL training and cultural enrichment program consisting of instruction in ESL areas:
- Listening/Speaking
- Reading/Writing.
- Labs will be held on weekdays following the instruction
- Variety of co-curricular activities to reinforce language skills and understanding of application
- Interactions with students from diverse cultures and backgrounds

# Residential Accommodations

- Students will live in FSU Housing with suite style living arrangements (4 double occupancy bedrooms, 2 full bathrooms, living room and mini kitchen/dining area)
- Oversized common lounge/lobby with space to study, Wi-Fi, television and fitness center
- Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner will be provided while on campus.





# Activities & Fee Structure

- 24 hours per week hours of classroom instruction and lab
- Service Learning and other hands-on learning activities
- Campus visits to other UNC System Schools
- Cultural excursions to places of local interest such as Raleigh Legislative Complex & Museums, Myrtle Beach or Wilmington Beach and other places in North Carolina
- Educational/Cultural visit and overnight stay at the Capital of the United States, Washington D.C.
- Shopping excursions
- Students will be awarded certificates upon successful completion of the camp
- \$ 2,600 per student for instruction, accommodation and meals (Meals while on excursion will be the responsibility of the student). This amount does not include international airfare or student health insurance.
